

## Policy on the composition of honors committee for undergraduates in the economics department

- 1) A committee consists of three individuals.
- 2) At least two members must be faculty members or one faculty member and one approved doctoral students within the economics department.
- 3) An approved doctoral student has passed oval comps and has written approval from the Director of Undergraduate Studies for that thesis committee.
- 4) A third member may be either a faculty member from the economics department or a KU (including KUMC) tenured or tenure-track faculty member from outside the department.
- 5) One of the members serves as the chair. The chair must be a faculty member in the economics department.
